Ageing

The wine is aged 18 months in vat. The wine is regulary pumped over to bring oxygen to the tannins while preserving the fruit.

Tasting Notes

A deep color with notes of red fruits and spices on the nose. The palate is long and charming with supple tannins.

Food pairing

"La vie en Bordeaux" goes well with grilled meats, entrecote steak, duck breast, and cheeses.
